


# **U.S. 1 Improvements**

From Myers Drive to Crane Creek Bridge

### **Project Description**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing safety improvements along U.S. 1 from Myers Drive to Crane Creek Bridge in Melbourne and Palm Bay. The project plans to resurface U.S. 1 within the corridor to extend the life of the existing roadway.

The project proposes pedestrian and bicycle enhancements, including restriping the travel lanes to provide a buffered bicycle lane from Myers Drive to University Boulevard. Pedestrian signal upgrades and the reconstruction of pedestrian curb ramps are also planned. Lighting will be enhanced at signalized intersections as well.

This project will also include parts of a Streetscape project from the city of Melbourne, which proposes pedestrian improvements, constructing raised medians from Avenida Del Rio to Crane Creek Bridge, and adding directional medians at Roosevelt Avenue and Jernigan Avenue (see graphic below and on other side). The raised medians and directional medians will restrict left turns from some side streets and driveways onto U.S. 1.
