


U.S. 27 Improvements

From County Road 33 to Middlesex Road

Lake County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing to resurface U.S. 27 (State Road (S.R.) 25) from County Road (C.R.) 33 to Middlesex Road to extend the life of the existing roadway.

In addition to repaving the corridor, other operational and safety enhancements include adding a southbound right turn lane to southbound C.R. 25A near the Lake County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Support Facility. Also, the project proposes to remove the obsolete section of the "Y intersection" on the west side of the road to improve the connection at C.R. 25A to the north, across from Saxon Road.

Drainage improvements and construction of a short segment of sidewalk from the Lakeside Apartments to the existing sidewalk north of C.R. 25A on northbound U.S. 27 is planned.
