## S.R. 426 Coalition, Orange County

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to Community Event #2 regarding the S.R. 426 Coalition from west of South Park Avenue to east of North Lakemont Avenue on Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. This is a maintenance project that will rehabilitate the pavement while incorporating proposed safety improvements within the existing roadway right-of-way. The goal of this effort is to improve the corridor for all users. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the community event. The same meeting materials will be presented across all platforms, including in person, virtual and by phone.
