

Pineda Causeway (S.R. 404) **Improvements**

From U.S. 1 to S.R. A1A








Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements to Pineda Causeway (State Road (S.R.) 404) from U.S. 1 to S.R. A1A in the Town of Palm Shores, Merritt Island and South Patrick Shores.

The project plans to repave all lanes of Pineda Causeway within the project limits, as well as the interchange ramps at U.S. 1, South Tropical Trail (County Road 3), and South Patrick Drive (S.R. 513). The roadway configuration will remain the same.

Other improvements include adding a bicycle through lane next to the right turn lane at the intersection of Pineda Causeway and S.R. A1A. The existing green bicycle markings at the interchange ramps will be refreshed. The project also plans to install wrong way detection systems on ramps that do not already have the technology.
