ROADWAY RESURFACING

I-95 from south of Malabar Road to north of Fiske Boulevard

Brevard County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing 24 miles of northbound and southbound Interstate 95 (I-95) from south of Malabar Road (State Road (S.R.) 514) to north of Fiske Boulevard (S.R. 519). The ramps at the following interchanges will also be repaved: Malabar Road, Palm Bay Road (County Road (C.R.) 516), U.S. 192, S.R. 518 (Eau Gallie Boulevard), S.R. 404 (Pineda Causeway), Wickham Road, and Fiske Boulevard.

Other improvements include building barriers to protect the overpass piers at Minton Road, S.R. 404, and Viera Boulevard, applying new deck coatings on the bridges over S.R. 518 and Lake Washington Road, upgrading pavement markings, and improving the Intelligent Transportation System (ITS).

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent nighttime single lane closures between 7 p.m. and 6:30 a.m. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution.

Electronic message boards and other signage will direct traffic through the work zone. The level of work activity and noise will vary during different construction phases. Motorists should anticipate areas of uneven pavement within the project limits, a common condition during construction when the contractor applies multiple asphalt layers in phases. Many of these roadway conditions are short-term and will gradually improve as the project progresses.
