Granada Boulevard (S.R. 40) at Water Oak Lane in Ormond Beach on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of this project is to enhance safety by converting the full median opening on W. Granada Boulevard at Water Oak Lane to a two-way directional median opening. FDOT is offering multiple ways to participate in the live meeting.
