PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is resurfacing U.S. 441/U.S. 27 from north of SE 178th Place in Summerfield to south of SE 62nd Avenue in Belleview.

Pedestrian curb ramps are being upgraded as needed to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Pavement markings and signage are also being updated to improve visibility and overall roadway safety.

WHAT TO EXPECT

When paving begins shortly into the project, motorists should expect intermittent nighttime single-lane closures between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. Drivers should use caution when traveling through the work zone. Electronic message boards and posted signs will help guide traffic safely through the area. The level of work activity and noise may vary throughout different phases of construction.

Motorists should also anticipate areas of uneven pavement within the project limits, a common condition during construction when the contractor applies multiple asphalt layers in phases. Many of these roadway conditions are short-term and will improve as the project progresses. Please note that the construction schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. 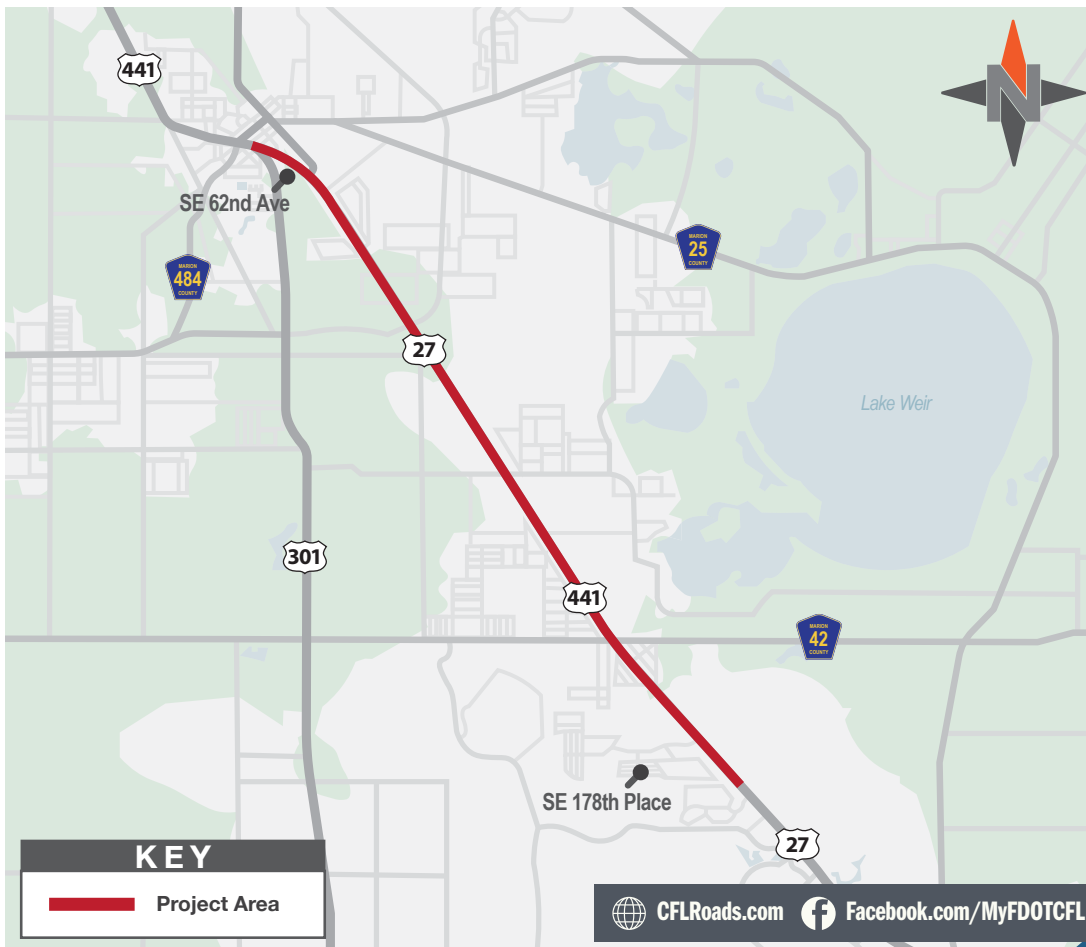
