

Interstate 95 (I-95) Resurfacing From south of State Road (S.R.) 50 to S.R. 46

Brevard County





Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning to repave the northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate 95 (I-95). The project will extend from south of State Road (S.R.) 50 to S.R. 46 in Titusville and Mims.

The purpose of this project is to maintain a safe and reliable roadway surface.

The project also includes resurfacing the I-95 ramps at the S.R. 50 and S.R. 46 interchanges.

At the S.R. 406 interchange, the project will repave all ramps and widen the northbound I-95 exit ramp, adding an additional turn lane for improved traffic flow.
