Project Description

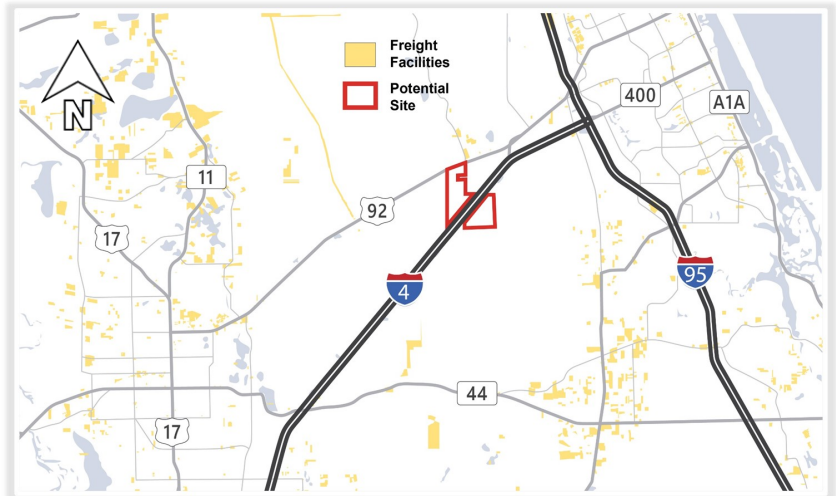
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning to construct truck and freight parking facilities adjacent to eastbound and westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) in Volusia County.

The proposed site is about 4.8 miles west of I-95 at the locations of former rest areas. Both facilities will be accessed using entrance and exit ramps on I-4.

The overall site is one of six potential sites identified along the I-4 corridor from Osceola County to Volusia County, and the only one in Volusia County. The preferred locations were determined during a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study, which is expected to finish in late 2023. The purpose of the project is to provide needed truck parking space to serve regional freight parking demand and enhance safety and mobility.

The proposed eastbound I-4 facility in Volusia County would cover about 73.3 acres and have room for an estimated 275 truck parking spaces. The westbound I-4 facility would encompass approximately 116 acres and have space for 253 truck parking spaces.

For both locations, a large restroom facility is proposed at the front of the truck parking site, and a small restroom facility is planned at the back of the site. Wildlife fencing and wildlife sensitive lighting will be provided due to the proximity of the existing wildlife crossing. Landscaping will also be included.
