

U.S. 301 (S.R. 35) Improvements from C.R. 470 to Florida's Turnpike (S.R. 91)

Financial Project Identification (FPID) Nos.: 430132-2, 430132-4, 430132-5



Project Description

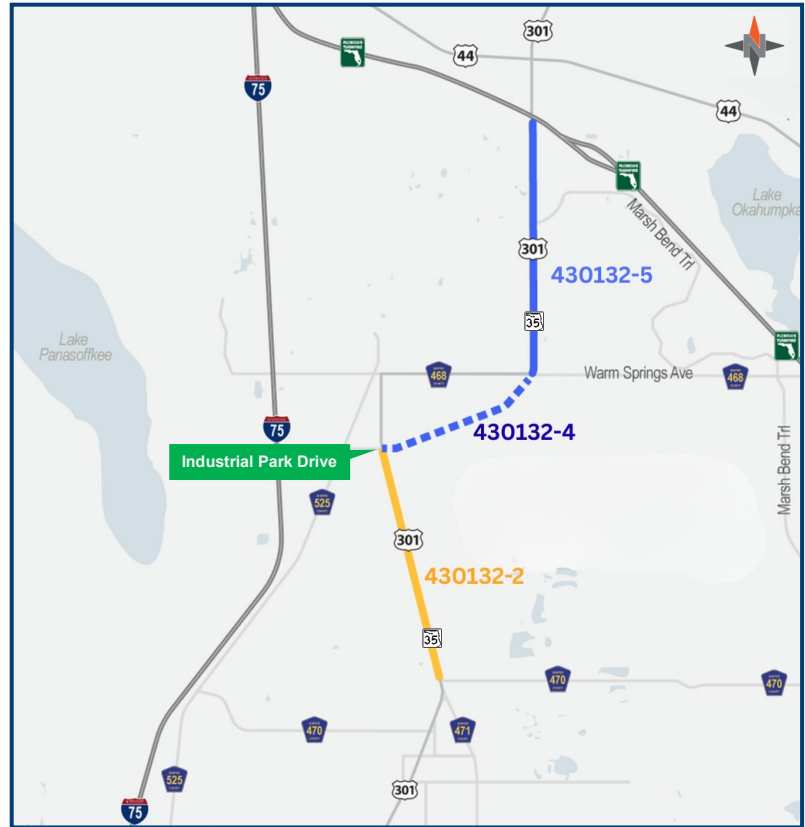
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is improving U.S. 301 (State Road (S.R.) 35) from County Road (C.R.) 470 to Florida's Turnpike in Sumter County.

FDOT plans to widen this portion of U.S. 301 to provide two travel lanes in each direction, separated by a grassed median.

The improvements will be constructed in three projects:

- FPID 430132-2 will widen U.S. 301 from C.R. 470 to Industrial Park Drive
- FPID 430132-4 is a realignment of U.S. 301 from Industrial Park Drive to Warm Springs Avenue. This project will also include improvements at the Florida's Turnpike interchange to help relieve congestion.
- FPID 430132-5 completes the widening from Warm Springs Avenue to Florida's Turnpike

In addition to widening, the project will add a shared-use path on both sides of the road, install traffic signals at Industrial Park Drive and Warm Springs Avenue, and build a roundabout at Marsh Bend Trail.

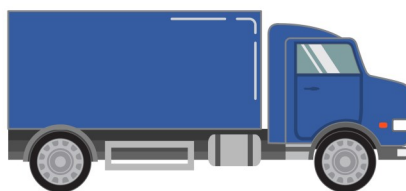


Right of way acquisition on the project is needed and is underway. FDOT is building the improvements under 430132-4 through a design-build contract that started earlier this year. Construction on the improvements at the U.S. 301 and Florida's Turnpike interchange is beginning fall 2025. Construction on the realigned portion of U.S. 301 is expected to start in spring 2026.

Addresses expected **traffic growth** and **congestion**.

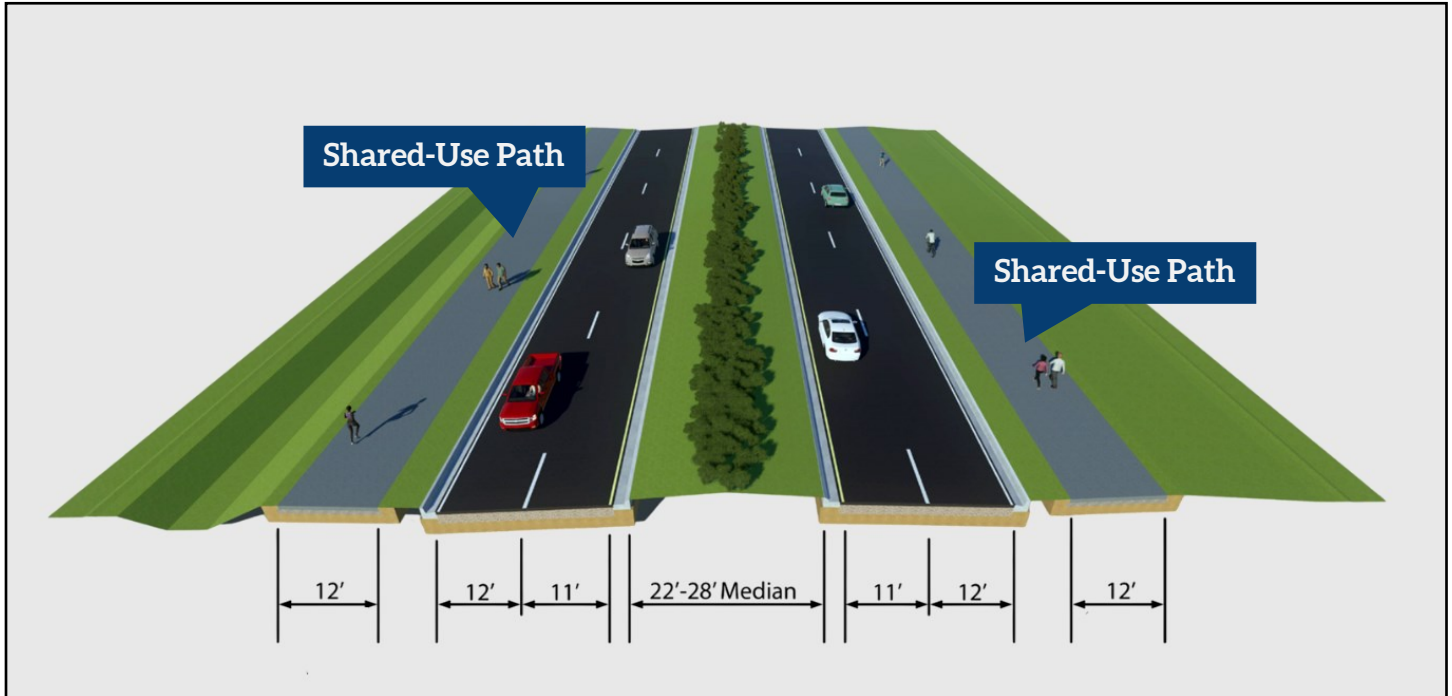


Accommodates **high volume** of existing and future **truck traffic**.
