BRIDGE MAINTENANCE

S.R. 46 over St. Johns River and Cabbage Slough waterway

Volusia County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is performing maintenance on two existing State Road (S.R.) 46 bridges. One bridge connects Volusia and Seminole Counties over the St. Johns River, and the other bridge carries S.R. 46 over the Cabbage Slough waterway in Volusia County.

Long columns, known as piles, form the supports for both bridges. The purpose of this project is to install fiberglass pile jackets around the existing bridge piles. Pile jackets are protective coverings that will reinforce the piles and extend the life of each bridge.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Motorists in Volusia and Seminole Counties should expect intermittent single lane closures at the two identified bridges throughout construction. Lane closures will only occur on one bridge at a time. During lane closures, the existing posted speed limit of 55 mph will be reduced to 45 mph within the work zone. Electronic message boards, road work signage, and flagging operations will be used to direct traffic around closures. Marine traffic access will be maintained during construction.

The level of work activity will vary during different phases of construction, and the schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
