BRIDGE DECK AND JOINT REHABILITATION

S.R. 492 (Bonnie Heath Boulevard) over the C.S.X. Railroad

Marion County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be making improvements to the State Road (S.R.) 492 (Bonnie Heath Boulevard) bridge over the C.S.X. Railroad in Marion County. Work includes concrete repair, joint rehabilitation, and applying an epoxy overlay to the bridge deck. The epoxy overlay is a type of coating that seals the concrete surface, which helps to prolong the life of the bridge. The overlay also increases friction on the traveling surface, making it safer for motorists.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect single lane closures during nighttime work. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct traffic through the work zone. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the bridge. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
