# **Modified Phased Design Build Project Information**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Five will be advertising a Modified Phased Design Build contract on November 3 to solicit qualified teams to reconstruct the Interstate 95 (I-95) at U.S. 1 (State Road 5) interchange in Ormond Beach, Volusia County. The limits of this project encompass approximately one mile north and one mile south of the interchange along I-95, as well as on U.S. 1 from Plantation Oaks Boulevard to Destination Daytona Lane, a distance of approximately one mile. The purpose of the project is address growing traffic volumes, relieve congestion, correct substandard features, and enhance safety.

### Scope of Work:

- Reconstruct I-95 within limits to create Diverging Diamond Interchange
  - Address high crashes on ramps and high truck volumes
  - Address substandard vertical curves and bridge clearances
  - Provide for future widening to 8 lanes

- Reconstruct I-95 bridges over FEC rail lines
- Widen U.S. 1 to 6 lanes with curb and gutter
- Create new frontage road in alignment with Ormond Gateway entrance
- Construct 14-foot-wide shared use path
- Signalization
- Environmental mitigation
