PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing safety improvements at the intersection of State Road (S.R.) 200 (SW College Road) and SW 60th Avenue in unincorporated Marion County, southwest of Ocala.

This project incorporates improvements identified through an FDOT safety study to reduce both the frequency and severity of crashes at this intersection. Work includes the installation of a second span wire to accommodate additional traffic signals, allowing each travel lane on S.R. 200 to have a dedicated signal. The traffic signals are also being upgraded with reflective backplates to improve visibility. Additional enhancements include improved intersection lighting,

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, lane closures will generally occur between 6:30 p.m. and 6 a.m. Electronic message boards and other signage will be in place to help guide motorists safely through the work zone.

Motorists are encouraged to reduce speed, follow posted signage, and remain alert while traveling through the work zone. The construction schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
