

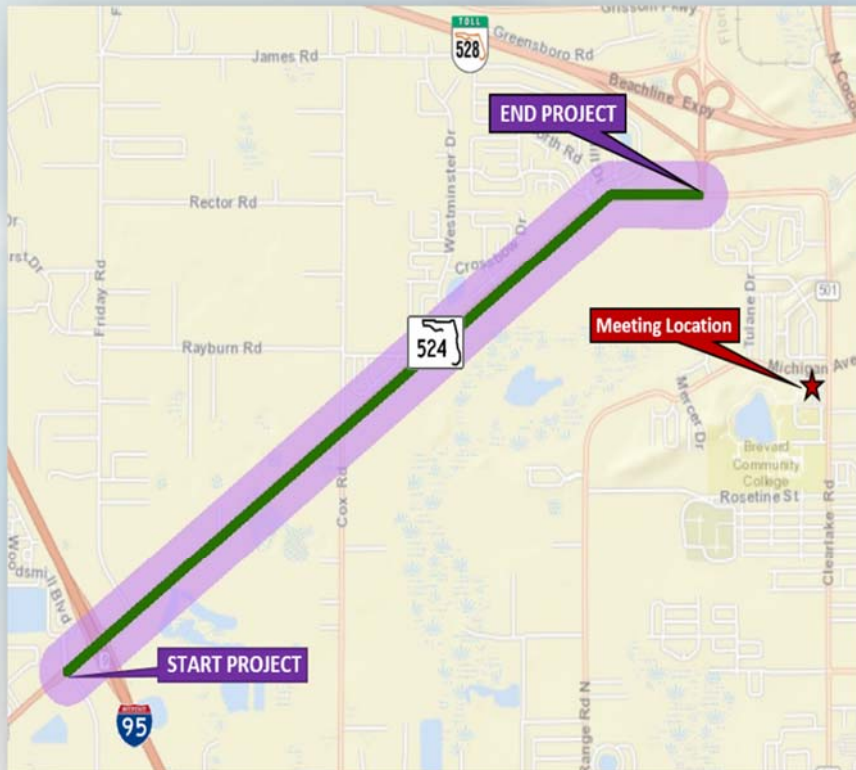

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a corridor planning study for **State Road (S.R.) 524 from Friday Road west of Interstate 95 (I-95) to Industry Road**.
